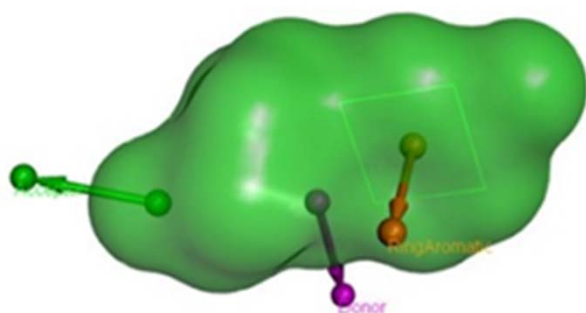


FBLD2016 (Boston): Edelris will present positive results obtained with 3D fragments on Cyclophilin-D.

Arguments that support the strong interest in 3D-fragments over traditionally flat heterocyclic structures will be illustrated by the positive results obtained on a FBLD collaborative program that led to the identification of a highly potent small molecule inhibitor of the peptidyl-prolyl isomerase Cyclophilin-D.
